IS MEDICAL TREATMENT NEEDED?

Monday - Friday 7AM -5PM CST

After Hours & Holidays

IS IT LIFE-THREATENING?

Immediately inform your supervisor.

Your supervisor will report the injury to LandrumHR who will authorize & direct medical treatment & drug test.* Your supervisor will direct you to the nearest Urgent Care.

Your supervisor will call 911 or send you to the nearest emergency room.

Transportation options for injuries include self-transportation, friend / family member transport, or commercial taxi.

- 1. Stay in contact with your supervisor & LandrumHR throughout your treatment & recovery process.
- **2**. After treatment, turn in all paperwork to your supervisor & LandrumHR at wcclaims@landrumhr.com or fax 850-478-4088.
- **3.** With your supervisor, complete, sign & submit the **Injury and Incident Investigation Report Form** and return it ASAP.
- **4.** Prescriptions can be filled at any pharmacy. Contact LandrumHR at 800-888-0472 x303 if any problems occur. If you self pay send all receipts & paperwork to LandrumHR at wccclaims@landrumhr.com for reimbursement.
